### Workshop Synopsis:

This highly interactive workshop provides you a combo of three interesting techniques and tools that could be useful in facilitation and training: **Storytelling, Rapid Learning and Debriefing.**

**Storytelling** enables you to link your workshop topic to your personal experience so that you could tailor a storyline that moves your audience. It allows your story to venture into other life experiences which makes learning more interesting. It creates a safe environment for your participants to share their valuable life experiences with one another and allow rapid learning within a short span of time.

**Rapid Learning** is a game-play stealing process. It enables participants to rapidly become engaged in a topic to stretch/build/enhance/deepen the topic content as the good energy of participants and EXTRA! Process unfolds naturally. This segment will be a live demonstration in which participants will learn the EXTRA! Facilitation process by actually doing it. This methodology was shared by David Chard at the Kuching Conference in 2008.

**Power Debriefing** enables you to help your workshop participants discover their "Ah-Ha's" in their learning and anchor them for immediate and future application effectively.

### Intended Outcomes of the Workshop:

At the end of the workshop, participants will be able to:

1. Understand the fundamentals and benefits of Storytelling in workshops and be able to design a session using Storytelling.
2. Facilitate a workshop using EXTRA! Technique to engage the group.
3. Conduct debriefing effectively so as to enable participants to derive optimum learning and lasting value from a workshop.
